Thank you for considering leaving a legacy to Green's Windmill Trust. Our *Will for the Mill* Legacies Fund is a vital part of our fundraising strategy, and we welcome gifts of any size.

Incorporating the Legacy in your Will

There are two ways to leave a legacy: a **pecuniary** gift which is a fixed sum of money, and a **residuary** gift which is the whole or a percentage of your estate. The latter is a good way of protecting your gift against inflation because the value of a fixed sum (the pecuniary gift) could decrease over time. However, we welcome both types of gift.

We recommend that anyone looking to pledge seek legal and/or financial advice from their Will-writer or solicitor before making any final decisions. You may also wish to discuss your intentions with your other beneficiaries and/or your executors. You may find it useful to give your Will-writer or solicitor the following suggested wording about giving to Green's Windmill Trust when preparing your gift.

▪ **For Pecuniary Gifts**

"I give the sum of £_____ [amount in words] to Green's Windmill Trust (also known as Green's Windmill and/or Green's Windmill and Science Centre) (Charity No 1163116), located at Greens Mill Science Centre, Windmill Lane, Sneinton, Nottingham, NG2 4QB to its *Will for the Mill* Legacies Fund and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other authorised officer of the Trust shall be a full and sufficient discharge.

▪ **For Residuary Gifts**

"I give [state proportion in words, for example ten percent or a quarter] of the residue of my estate to Green's Windmill Trust (also known as Green's Windmill and/or Green's Windmill and Science Centre) (Charity No 1163116), located at Greens Mill Science Centre, Windmill Lane, Sneinton, Nottingham, NG2 4QB to its *Will for the Mill* Legacies Fund and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other authorised officer of the Trust shall be a full and sufficient discharge.

If you already have a Will we suggest asking your Will-writer or solicitor to add a Codicil to it outlining the type of legacy you wish to leave to Green's Windmill Trust.

For Information: Resolution of Green's Windmill Trust Directors September 2025

Directors of Green's Windmill Trust resolved that there be established a separate Fund to be known initially as the "Will for the Mill Legacies Fund". This Fund will receive any legacies or bequests made to the Trust. The monies held within the Fund (unless expressly limited by the legator or person who made the bequest) shall be permitted to be used for any capital or revenue purpose of the powers of the Trust and specifically its objects which are:

1. To advance public education in particular but not limited to preserving the Green's Mill and Science Centre for the benefit of the public.
2. The advancement of heritage for the public benefit by promoting the charitable work of Green's Mill and Science Centre.

The Fund will be administered by the Heritage Development Officer working with the Treasurer of the Trust.
